# What is Insights?

 Insights is a business intelligence tool

 Connects data points, giving you a holistic view of your business

 Allows you to perform Data Analytics and Reporting

What is the difference between Data **Analytics** and **Reporting?** 

 Reporting is the collation of data into an organised format

 Data Analytics involves using the same data to make informed business decisions

#### Reporting

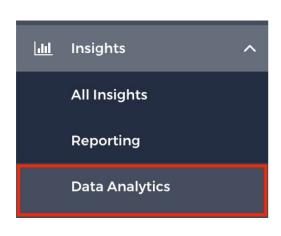


 Typically small data windows (Within the last month)

Required quickly

Quickly analysed or actioned

## Data Analytics



 Typically involves larger amounts of data from wider time frames

Less importance on instant data availability

 Carefully analysed to shape business decisions

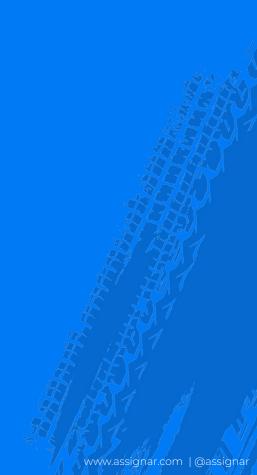
Use data analytics when....

Fieldworkers are allocated to a job

Pre-start/Safety Check forms are completed

Timesheets are completed by the Fieldworkers based on their completed works
